The Association of Inhalation Toxicologists (AIT) conference will take place on **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> to Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023 in Gothenburg, Sweden** bringing together many of the world's leading experts in the field of inhalation toxicology from a variety of backgrounds including respiratory medicine, CROs, the pharmaceutical, agrochemical, environmental and chemicals industries, regulatory authorities, academia, manufacturing and technology companies (in person conference not virtual).
